

Exhibit 12: Claim Form

A SETTLEMENT HAS BEEN CREATED, AND YOU MAY BE ENTITLED TO A CASH PAYMENT.

Use this Claim Form only if:

- (1) You are an automotive recycler or salvager that purchased a Subject Vehicle containing a Takata Inflator (as defined in the Settlement Agreement) and currently engage or, at the time of the purchase, were engaged in the business of automotive salvage or recycling, or that recycled, refurbished, or removed for sale or re-sale, second-hand Takata Inflators or Takata Inflator-related component parts;
- (2) You have or had recalled Takata Inflators;
- (3) You are not otherwise excluded from the Class; and
- (4) You otherwise meet the terms and conditions specified in this Claim Form and the Settlement Agreement.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Some vehicles included in the Settlement will be recalled at a later date and others may not require a recall. Your receipt of a Settlement Notice does not mean your vehicle is subject to a recall. Please refer to BMW's website, www.bmwusa.com/safety-and-emission-recalls, or the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration's website, www.SaferCar.gov, for the latest information about Takata recalls and to determine if your vehicle is subject to a recall.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUBMITTING A CLAIM FOR SETTLEMENT BENEFITS

Please Read These Instructions Carefully

1. Subject to certain limited exclusions, you are a person or entity eligible to submit a claim for a Settlement Payment if:
 - a. You are an Automotive Recycler located in the United States, the District of Columbia, and the territories and possessions of the United States prior to the date of the Preliminary Approval Order, April 4, 2023.
 - b. "Automotive Recyclers" means all persons who and entities which purchased a Subject Vehicle, as defined below, containing a Takata Inflator, as defined below, and that currently engage in, or at the time of such purchase were engaged in, the business of automotive salvage or recycling, or that recycled, refurbished, or removed for sale or re-sale, second-hand Takata Inflators or Takata Inflator-related component parts.
 - c. "Takata Inflator" or "Takata Inflators" mean Takata PSAN inflators, which are all airbag inflators for driver- or passenger front airbags which Takata manufactured and sold containing propellant with Phase-Stabilized Ammonium Nitrate ("PSAN"), including 2004 and 2004L propellant, whether desiccated or non-desiccated.
 - d. To submit a claim for a Settlement Benefit, you must submit a Claim Form to Car-Part.com, BMW's Settlement Claims Administrator, by going to www.recyclerpayment.org to download additional Claim Forms.
2. The deadline for submitting a Claim Form is two years from the date of implementation. Current date of implementation is anticipated to be December 6, 2023, but this date may move. Please periodically check the settlement website (www.recyclerpayment.org) for updates.

IMPORTANT: NO CLAIM FORMS MAY BE SUBMITTED AFTER THE FINAL CLAIM DEADLINE. THE DATE OF IMPLEMENTATION AND THE FINAL CLAIM DEADLINE ARE NOT YET KNOWN, BUT WILL BE POSTED PROMINENTLY ON THE SETTLEMENT WEBSITE, WWW.RECYCLERPAYMENT.ORG, WHEN THEY ARE KNOWN.

3. If you are the registered owner of more than one Subject Vehicle, you may submit one Claim Form for multiple vehicles, providing information for each individual vehicle.
4. Capitalized terms in this Form have the same meaning as provided in the Settlement Agreement, which is available for download at www.airbagrecyclersettlement.com. The Long Form Notice, which is also available for download www.airbagrecyclersettlement.com or by calling (833) 630-4683, also explains key terms of the Settlement, including the definition of Effective Date.
5. Provide all requested information and submit your Claim Form(s) to Car-Part.com as directed on the Claim Form or use the online form at www.recyclerpayment.org.
